

Advanced Level 1 Avalanche Education Course

These Advanced Level 1 avalanche classes are offered for those who have recently taken an AIARE (or equivalent) Level 1 course and will greatly benefit from a follow-up course that applies the level 1 curriculum in a practical "touring" environment. This is a 3 day/2night course hosted at the Braun Huts and enrollment is limited to only 7 students per course.

Students can expect to enhance their decision-making ability in a "guided" scenario that utilizes avalanche terrain and focuses on:

- Appropriate backcountry gear
- Safe travel techniques in avalanche terrain
- Communication both prior to and on slope
- Collecting and Documenting snow science data
- Companion rescue techniques and procedure.

What you need: All participants should be comfortable on backcountry touring gear, either touring skis with skins or splitboard with skins. All meals and trail snacks, sleeping bag, note pad and pencil or pen, hot drinks-coffee/tea/cocoa, avalanche beacon, shovel and probe, headlamp.
